Memes can be in English, French, or both.

- Any meme generator or tech tool can be used (Google Drawings, Meme Dad, etc).
- Memes with references to sex, alcohol, drugs or violence will not be accepted.
- French teacher of student(s) must be an AATF member.
- There is a limit of five entries per school. Students can work in groups.

Competition Divisions: (1) Intermediate: Grades 6-8, (2) Secondary: Grades 9 - 12

Judging Criteria: Visual impact, relevance to theme, and originality.

Technology Considerations: Students may use any meme creation or editing websites to construct their submissions.
