Please review the format guidelines below for more details.

Theme: Mon Français, Mon Avenir / My French, My Future

Deadline: Posters must scanned and emailed by November 15, 2018

Guidelines:

- 8 ½ x 11, must be scanned and submitted digitally
- Color or black & white drawings or paintings
- NO copyrighted designs or computer-generated art. Original artwork only. No group work.
- Captions (optional) may be in English or in French.
- Schools may submit up to 5 original projects.
- On the back of the project, please write (1) student name, (2) school name, (3) grade level, (4) competition division, (5) name of French teacher, and (6) email address of teacher.
- French teacher of student artist must be an AATF member.

Competition divisions: (1) Elementary: K-5, (2) Intermediate: Grades 6 – 8, (3) Secondary: Grades 9 – 12

Judging Criteria: Visual impact, relevance to National French Week theme, originality.

All artwork becomes the property of the AATF and may be used in AATF publications or materials.

Prizes: All participants in the poster competition will receive certificates. First, second, and third place winners of each division will receive prizes. The winning posters will be posted on the AATF website.
